



TENT KORIMAKO - Accessibility Guide

Helping every guest make an informed decision before booking

Our Commitment

At **Drift Off Grid**, we believe every guest deserves clear, honest information so they can decide whether our accommodation is suitable for their individual needs.

Tent Korimako is our most accessible eco structure. While we have incorporated a range of accessibility features, it is located within a natural rural environment and may not be suitable for every guest.

If you have specific accessibility requirements, we encourage you to contact us before booking. We are always happy to discuss your needs, answer questions and provide additional information to help you decide whether Tent Korimako is the right fit for your stay.

Arrival & Parking

- ✓ Guests may drive directly to Tent Korimako.
- ✓ Parking is located immediately beside the accommodation.
- ✓ Approximately **2 metres** from the vehicle to the entrance.
- ✓ Flat route from parking to the entrance.
- ✓ Standard vehicles can access the accommodation in normal weather conditions.
- ✓ Four-wheel drive is not required.



Paths & Outdoor Surfaces

Vehicle access is via a gravel driveway.

The short path from the parking area to the entrance is level and provides easy access to the front door.

Outdoor surfaces include:

- Compacted gravel
- Timber decking

Please note that gravel and timber surfaces may become slippery during wet weather.

Entrance

A portable access ramp is available to provide step-free access onto the front deck.

The entrance is directly beside the parking area, eliminating long walking distances between your vehicle and the accommodation.

Interior Layout

Tent Korimako is arranged on a **single level** and includes:

- Open-plan bedroom
- Lounge area
- Kitchenette
- Bathroom
- Private outdoor deck

The spacious open-plan design provides generous circulation space compared with many glamping-style accommodations. Furniture can also be repositioned where practical to create additional room if required.

Bathroom Accessibility

The bathroom includes:

- ✓ Accessible-height toilet
- ✓ Toilet grab rail
- ✓ Walk-in shower
- ✓ Shower grab rail
- ✓ Shower seat available on request

The bathroom has been designed to improve comfort and independence for many guests with reduced mobility.

Bedroom

- Super King bed
- Access available from both sides of the bed
- Generous circulation space around the bed

Additional measurements, including bed height and clearances, are available upon request.

Outdoor Features

Tent Korimako also includes:

- Private outdoor bath (*one step to access the bath deck*)
- Outdoor seating area on the main deck (*accessible via the portable ramp*)
- Outdoor firepit (*accessed via a compacted gravel path beside the eco structure*)

These features are positioned within the natural landscape. Some outdoor areas include changes in level and may not be suitable for every guest with reduced mobility.

Lighting

- ✓ Well-lit entrance
- ✓ Interior LED lighting throughout
- ✓ Exterior lighting around the entrance and deck

To protect our exceptional night sky and minimise disturbance to native wildlife, exterior lighting is intentionally subtle.

A torch is available for guests who require additional lighting when moving around outside after dark.

Things to Consider

Tent Korimako is located in a peaceful native bush setting rather than an urban environment.

Before booking, please consider that:

- Outdoor areas include compacted gravel surfaces.
- The accommodation is surrounded by native bush.
- Weather conditions may influence outdoor comfort.
- Some guest experiences, including the outdoor bath and firepit, require movement around the property.
- Emergency services are approximately **20–30 minutes** away.

Assistance Available

We are pleased to prepare the following before your arrival upon request:

- ✓ Portable access ramp
- ✓ Shower seat
- ✓ Additional measurements, including bed height, door widths and accommodation layout
- ✓ Assistance planning your arrival

If there is anything else that would help make your stay more comfortable, please let us know before you arrive.

Questions We May Ask Before Your Stay

To help us prepare for your arrival, we may ask a few simple questions.

Mobility

- Do you use a wheelchair, walker or another mobility aid?
- Would you like the portable access ramp installed before arrival?
- Would you like the shower seat prepared for your stay?

- Are you comfortable walking on compacted gravel surfaces?

Bathroom Requirements

- Are the existing grab rails suitable for your needs?
- Do you require any additional bathroom equipment?

Arrival

- Would you like us to explain the accommodation layout before you arrive?
- Would assistance on arrival be helpful?

General

- Do you have any medical equipment requiring electricity?
- Is there anything else we can do to help make your stay more comfortable?
